CAFOD Big Lent Walk 2025: Saturday 8th March! The aim is to do a part stage of the English 'Camino', 5 miles in total. Starting at our church at **10.00a.m prompt**, Father Joe will lead us in a small Jubilee Celebration. We will learn about the Holy door, and fulfil an indulgence ingredient, which will be followed by a period of prayer together at the Shrine of our Lady of Caversham. We will listen to an explanation from the Confraternity of St James of how the walk we are about to embark on ties into the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. Leaving the Church for our at 10.30, we will pause at the Camino mural in Friar Street, walking onto Reading Abbey via St James, and then along the Kennet into beautiful countryside following the tow path, as far as the Cuning Man pub in Burghfield*. Then the number 2 bus back into Reading. We will be joined as usual by the other Reading churches, hopefully in big numbers. Total time allowing for stops, hymns led by our wonderful music group and prayer, is expected to be 3 hours.*
