Traditionally the Easter collection goes directly to the parish priest as part of their annual income. Please collect an envelope on your way out or you can give on the contactless machines.

Easter basket blessing

Many parishioners have asked about the significance of the Blessing of Easter baskets which is of significant importance in Poland and many Eastern European countries. The contents of the basket include: beautifully decorated hardboiled eggs, meat (normally smoked sausage and ham), salt, horseradish, sourdough bread (unleavened), butter and Babka (a plain yeast cake), in the shape of a Lamb.



- ❖ Eggs symbolise life and Christ's resurrection.
- ❖ Bread is symbolic of Jesus.
- ❖ Lamb represents Christ.
- ❖ Salt represents purification.
- ❖ Horseradish is symbolic of the bitter sacrifice of Christ.
- ❖ Meat symbolises great joy and abundance.

The basket of food is blessed in Church on Easter Saturday and remains untouched until Sunday Morning, eaten as breakfast, and shared with family and friends. So really, it's far more than just a simple Easter basket tradition.

Please bring your families and baskets for a lovely Service and Blessing which will take place on **Saturday 19th April at 10am** at Our Lady and St. Annes.
