De La Salle Club, Bethlehem

During a trip to the Holy Land in February, Mike and those travelling with him witnessed first-hand the devastation caused locally for those who rely on tourism for a living.

In Bethlehem, they met Laila and Maria Asfoura and their family who run a pilgrim tour operating company. They have had to close the office, lay off staff and work from their home in the hope that things will pick up again.

Maria, through her children, is very heavily involved in the De La Salle Club of Bethlehem, which is linked to the De La Salle school. The club provides sports facilities and coaching to both Christian and Muslim children in and around Bethlehem and is now the only such club left. It is particularly well known for its swimming and has produced a number of Palestinian Olympic team swimmers.

Sadly, the parents are no longer able to fund the school and, like the rest, it is in danger of closing. Maria contacted Mike to see if there was anything he could do to help in the form of making a donation as the parents have commenced a proactive fund-raising campaign in order to keep the club open for their children. Dear Parish Community,

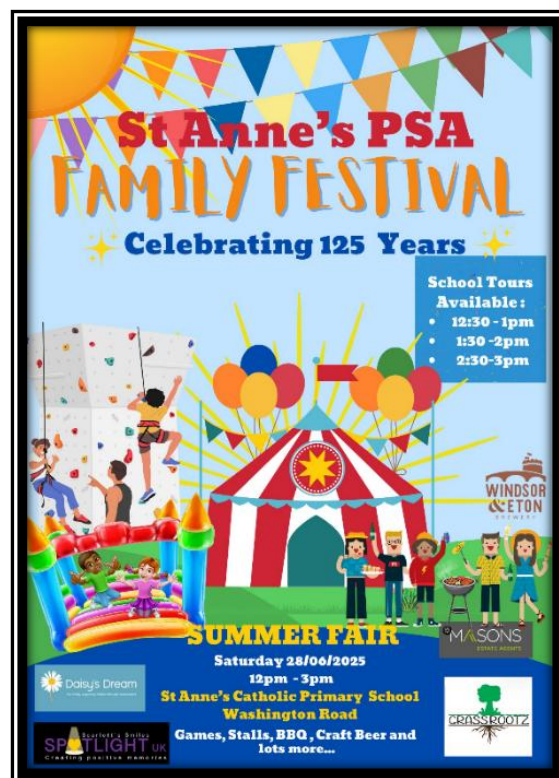
We're excited to invite past pupils and former staff of St Anne's to a special
